Job Description

Post Title: 1 Year/Maternity Cover Early Years/KS1 Mainscale Class Teacher

The Postholder will be required to:

Teaching and Learning

- To be an excellent classroom practitioner
- To teach engaging and effective lessons which motivate and challenge, using the Strand Infants Pedagogy including a commitment to outdoor learning.
- To plan for progression across the ability range in your class, ensuring that all learners are challenged / supported as required.
- To write IEPs and work closely with the SENCO (and other external professionals) in ensuring high quality provision for pupils with SEND, attending annual reviews as required.
- With high expectations, use assessment to inform target setting where children understand next steps in their learning.
- To share responsibility for Foundation Stage / KS1 curriculum planning, in consultation with other year group practitioners and year group leader, including planning and leaving direction for PPA teacher.
- To take care of the classroom and communal environments so that they are appropriate, calm and tidy; displaying children's work and 'telling the story' of what we do here at Strand Infants.
- To consistently uphold our six values, developing these at every opportunity with children and staff.
- To develop positive relationships with children, following our school behaviour policy; with a positive and therapeutic approach to behaviour at all times.
- Provide parents/ carers with regular information on the curriculum and children's ongoing progress, working in warm partnership with parents.
- To work with Swan Centre staff and children to ensure appropriate inclusion and high quality provision for our pupils in ASC provision linked to your class.
- Demonstrate commitment to continuing professional development by attending relevant courses, conferences, reading etc
- Take a full, interested and informed role in the continued development of the whole curriculum.
- Regularly check the diary and liaise flexibly with SLT in effective organisation and timetabling (including supporting with reasonable cover arrangements)
- Carry out other duties of a class teacher as outlined in the School Teacher's pay and Conditions document .

Leadership

- Lead a curriculum area across the school. (or demonstrate the ability to do so in the future.)
- Provide parents, visitors and the GB with information related to an area of responsibility.
- Contribute to the fuller, wider life of school by attending some of our 'Friends Events' and providing a teacher led club at some point in each academic year.
- Demonstrate effective leadership and positive partnership with teaching assistants working in your class/ year group.

Safeguarding

- Ensure the safety of the children in your care, doing any necessary risk assessments when required.
- Follow the school Child Protection policy; being vigilant of concerns and sharing this quickly through our agreed procedures and use of CPOMS.

These duties may be varied to meet the changing demands of the school and/or the developing career aspirations of the teacher. Any amendments shall be subject to consultation between the Headteacher and the teacher concerned. The Postholder is required to carry out the duties of a school teacher as set out in the School Teacher's Pay and Conditions Document.
