

Playcare Assistant Job Description

Responsible to: Playcare Leader & Headteacher

Job purpose: to provide a safe, welcoming and interesting aftercare club experience for children of the school ranging in ages from 4 – 11 years.

Duties & Responsibilities

- To ensure all the aftercare club and or breakfast club policies and procedures are implemented and maintained.
- To encourage the active involvement of the children in the planning and development of the activity programme.
- Ensure a range of age appropriate activities are available and to assist the Play leader in the planning, delivery and clearing up of all activities.
- To be a good role model, use positive behaviour management strategies when working with the children in aftercare club and build good relationships with the children and other staff.

Health & Safety

- Record any accidents in the accident book and report to School Office.
- Ensure that food preparation is carried out to required standards and that food offered meets healthy eating standards and assist.
- To be familiar with all emergency & security procedures e.g. Fire
 procedures, routines for collecting children and have a good awareness of
 H&S issues relevant to the school environment.
- Dress should be smart, comfortable and appropriate for the job which requires indoor and outdoor duties. Trousers are acceptable but Jeans are not allowed. Tops/ Tee-shirts should cover shoulders and not be low cut.
- Be aware of school policies and procedures, and school rules- in particular the behaviour policy & procedures.
